1002 Complaints Concerning Instructional MaterialsBoard Action: APPROVEDEffective Date: 8-20-15

The Board of Directors takes great care in the school adoption of instructional materials and is aware that all adopted materials may not be acceptable to all students, their parents/guardians.

The Executive Director/Principal or designee shall establish procedures which will permit proper consideration of any complaints against the use of any instructional materials, including textbooks, supplementary textbooks, library books, and other instructional materials and equipment.

The Board of Directors believes the Executive Director/Principal or designee and staff are well qualified to consider complaints concerning instructional materials. Complainants are advised to consider and accept the Executive Director/Principal or Designee decision as final.

However, if the complainant finds the decision of the Executive Director/Principal or Designee unsatisfactory, he/she may request that the matter be placed on the agenda of a regular Board meeting.

The Board of Directors' decision in any such case will be based on educational suitability and will not be influenced by a desire to suppress information or deny students access to ideas with which the Board of Directors disagrees.
