English Language Proficiency Assessment

Board Action: APPROVED Effective Date: November, 14, 2022

Pursuant to Ed. Code section 306, it is the policy of Temecula Valley Charter School (TVCS), that all students whose home language survey indicates a language other than English are assessed using the English Language Proficiency Assessment for California (ELPAC), or an alternate to determine English language proficiency.

Pursuant to 5 CCR §11511, initial assessments shall be administered as follows:

- (1) Any pupil whose primary language is other than English as determined by the home language survey and who has not previously been identified as an English learner by a California public school or for whom there is no record of results from an administration of an English language proficiency test, shall be assessed for English language proficiency with the test within 30 calendar days after the date of first enrollment in a California public school, or within 60 calendar days before the date of first enrollment, but not before July 1 of that school year.
- (2) Annual assessments shall be administered as follows:
 - a. The English language proficiency of all currently enrolled English learners shall be assessed by administering the test during the annual assessment window.
